A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA SUPPORTING; EFFORTS BY THE LEGISLATURE TO BRING RELIEF AND REFORMS TO OUR UNAFFORDABLE AND UNSUSTAINABLE INSURANCE SYSTEM PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate, deems it to be in the best interests of the City and the entire State to support efforts by the 2008 Legislature to bring relief and reforms to our unaffordable and unsustainable insurance system; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate supports the Chief Financial Officer Sink's "Cat Fund Risk Reduction Plan", this Plan provides opportunity for the reinsurance market to utilize private dollars for its coverage, thereby removing the threat from financial catastrophe for all Floridians; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate supports expansion of the "My Safe Florida Home Program" and endorses a partnership with the private sector which will promote efficient home mitigation through a Zero-Interest Loan Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Margate, promotes the partnership with the private sector to bring relief and reforms to our unaffordable and unsustainable insurance system.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MARGATE, FLORIDA:

Section 1: The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: The City Commission of the City of Margate hereby supports efforts by the 2008 Florida Legislature to bring relief and reforms to our unaffordable and unsustainable insurance system.

Section 3: That the City Clerk is directed to send a copy of this resolution to.

SECTION 4:All resolutions or parts of resolutions on in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5:If any clause, section, other part of application of the Resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

SECTION 6:This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
