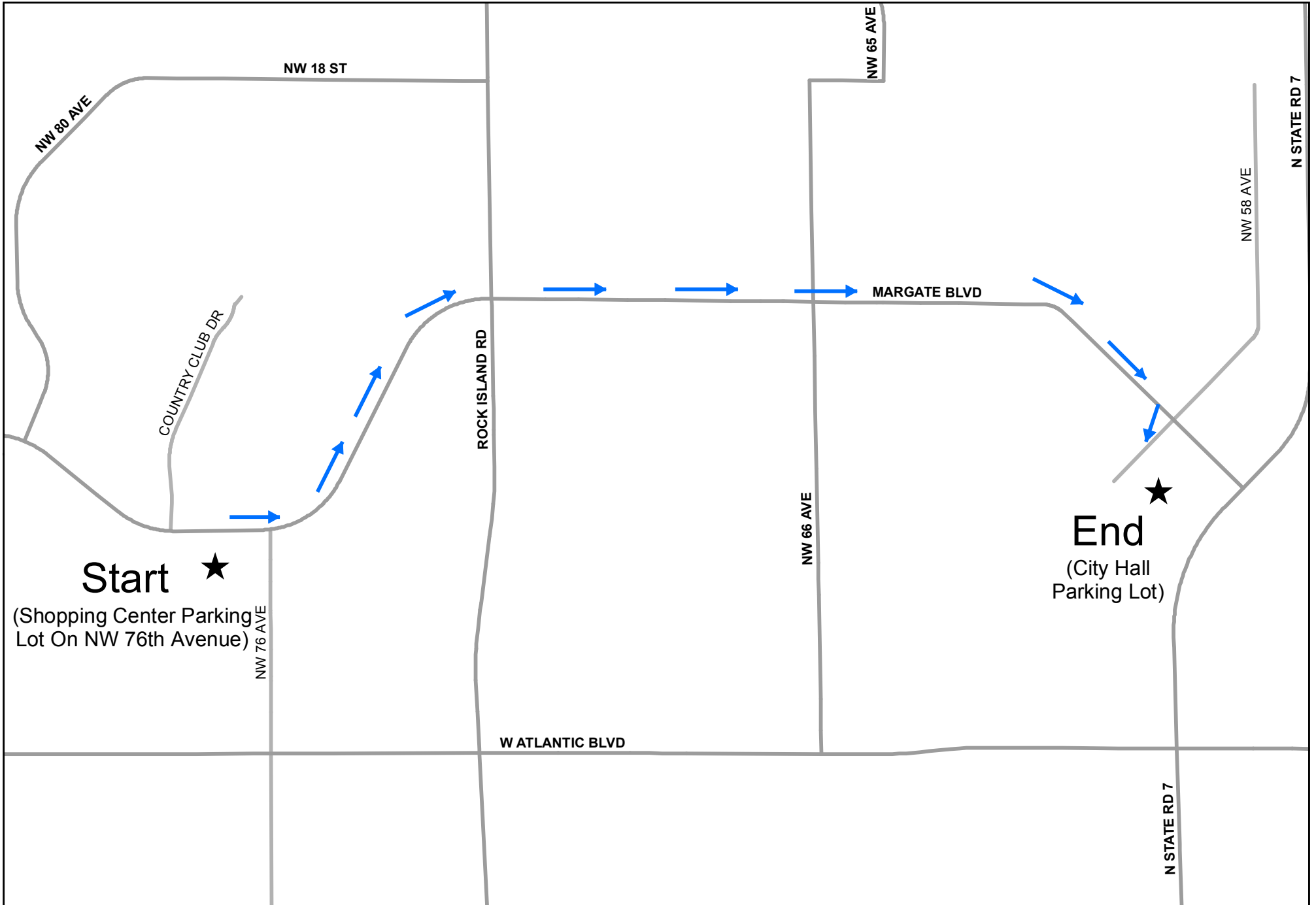
FLOAT CRITERIA

1. Floats are expected to be decorated - The theme of the Parade is “Red, White, & Blue”
2. The only undecorated vehicles that are permitted in the parade are those that either carry city-invited guests of honor or tow a float.
3. Walkers are permitted provided that they form a “human float”.
4. Adult spotters must walk along any motorized entry that carries a child(ren).
5. No flag shall be flown higher than the US Flag on any particular entry.
6. Entry sponsor and/or business names may be displayed on a sign; however, sole and blatant advertising of a business and/or product(s) is prohibited.
7. No alcoholic beverages of any type (whether open or closed; whether directly accessible or not) may be carried or transported in any manner during any part of the entire parade event.
8. You are to advise Parks and Recreation staff prior to July 4 in the event that you make any changes to your entry that are different from the information provided on your entry form.
9. Any items (candy or flyers) that you wish to distribute along the parade route shall be approved by Parks and Recreation Department staff prior to July 4.
10. You may not stop at any point along the parade route except in front of the Grandstand Area.
11. The parade starting/staging area is at the farthest point west on Margate Boulevard.
12. Please provide a brief written description of your entry and what you would like our parade emcee to say when you pass the Grandstand.
