Margate's Tropical Storm Ernesto Update #1

Margate, FL, August 29, 2006 – The City of Margate has determined the following updates due to Tropical Storm Ernesto.

- **Margate City hall** will continue to be **closed for normal business** on Wednesday August 29, 2006. When in doubt regarding reporting to work, ask your department supervisor if you are considered emergency personnel or if your services are needed.

- **Margate Inner-City Transit** will be closed on Tuesday at 3 p.m. following Broward County mass Transit's lead and may continue to be closed Wednesday August 30, 2006 depending on weather conditions. After the storm, call the **Margate Transit** line for more information: 954-972-5497.

- **Waste Management will NOT conduct regular trash pick-up** routes **Wednesday** August 30th but have rescheduled a pick-up day for Saturday September 2, 2006 for those whose regular pick-up day is Wednesday.

- The Wednesday **City Commission Meeting** for August 30, 2006 remains scheduled for its original time with a modified agenda.
