Friday, September 2, 2005 – The following is the debris pick-up update.

Crews started picking up horticultural debris today at the north end of the city and will continue through Thursday of next week. Ray Brenner, Public Works Director asks that the residents “please be patient and bare with us as we are working as hard as we can to get this job done.”

The scheduled plan for Saturday, September 3rd is to start with the Coral Bay neighborhood.

Hurricane Katrina produced 2500-3000 cubic yards of debris in Margate. Last years hurricanes created 45,000 cubic yards in the city.
