Wednesday September 7, 2005 – The following is today's hurricane horticultural debris pick-up update.

A message from James Veach of Waste Management of South Florida:

Clean-up efforts are complete for all areas North of Atlantic Blvd, and including Atlantic Blvd. Early this afternoon, work crews began working the area West of 441, South of Atlantic Blvd, and North of Southgate Blvd.

Work concluded today at the 6300 block of NW 1 Street, where they will resume tomorrow morning. At this time, there are no plans for a "second pass" of neighborhoods already cleaned up by work crews. However, exceptions may be made for those residents who have already phoned in claiming that they did not have their material out while work crews were in their area.

In addition, to the work crews cleaning up hurricane material, we continue to operate clam shell vehicles that are providing bulk collection service. Unfortunately, many residents continue to mix the bulk material with hurricane generated material which slows down the collection process. We expect to be finished with the city on Tuesday or Wednesday of next week.
