## **Margate Commissioners serve Florida League of Cities Council on Legislative Priorities**

Margate, FL, October 3, 2006 – The Florida League of Cities recently sent notification to Florida Cities requesting that they be represented on one or more the League’s newly restructured Legislative Councils. Four Margate City Commissioners were appointed to serve as members for each of the League’s Legislative Policy Councils.

The League currently has four legislative policy councils. Council members are appointed annually for a one-year term to establish positions and priorities on issues affecting their particular policy area. The councils will address and consider broader municipal issue areas that will be considered by the Legislature.

The issues of the four councils are then combined into one document and submitted to the Legislative Committee for review, amendments and approval. That consolidated statement is then brought before the League’s membership for final adoption.

“I am honored that President Flowers selected me and three other Margate Commissioners for a position on the new councils,” says Vice Mayor David McLean. “I am excited about this opportunity to help establish legislative priorities on our various municipal issues to benefit all of the cities and citizens of Florida.”

“Officials in Margate are serving their community with distinction and we are honored to have their talents, energy and dedication as part of this council. Our cities and our citizens will be well-served by their efforts as we work with the Legislature to help make our communities stronger and better prepared for the challenges we face” said FLC President Rene Flowers, Vice Chair, City of St. Petersburg.

Members of these councils are required to meet four times from September 15, 2006 through August 16, 2007. The four Councils include: Municipal Services Delivery Council in which Vice Mayor David McLean will serve, Urban Planning Council in which Commissioner Arthur Bross will serve, the Fiscal Stewardship Council in which Commissioner Pam Donovan will serve, and the Home Rule Administration Council which Commissioner Joseph Varsallone will serve.
