Margate's Update Regarding Hurricane Wilma

Margate FL, October 23, 2005 – The City of Margate has declared a state of emergency and has taken all necessary precautions to prepare for Hurricane Wilma. Following city policy, City Hall will be closed on Monday October 24, 2005.

Margate Intercity Transit has been suspended for Monday October 24, 2005.

Margate, as well as Broward County, has issued a mandatory mobile home evacuation. Please prepare accordingly.

Per Waste Management the previously scheduled trash pickup that was to occur on Monday morning at 5:00 am has been **cancelled**. At this point, the City has been told that residents should plan on their normal trash pick-up day, as long as weather permits. An **IMPORTANT REMINDER**...KEEP HURRICANE DEBRIS SEPARATE FROM OTHER TRASH. Because hurricane debris pick-up is FEMA-related, prepare for a six to ten day delay for pick up.
