Margate FL, October 25, 2005 – At this time, Margate City Officials are working on getting the city communications systems working, clearing the roads and ensuring city safety.

The Fall Festival and Grand Finale Celebration to the City's 50th Anniversary originally scheduled for the weekend of October 28-30, 2005 has been postponed until further notice.

The City of Margate has NOT issued a boil water notice. However, the city is urging residents to conserve water, which includes reducing the frequency of toilet flushes.

The city has issued a city-wide curfew in effect through the hours of 7:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m. It will remain in effect until further notice.

Because of the extent of the debris, we ask that residents please remain patient with regard to hurricane debris pick-up. Remember to **KEEP ALL HURRICANE DEBRIS SEPARATE** from regular trash pick up. Regular household trash pick-up will be dictated by Waste Management.
