Recovery Continues In Margate

Margate FL, October 26, 2005 –Margate City Hall remains closed for normal business on Wednesday. However, all full-time city employees are required to report to work at their normally scheduled time. Check with your department head for further information.

When clearing debris, remember do not obstruct roadways or sidewalks, but move the debris to the swale for pickup. Debris pickup has been scheduled to start Thursday October 27. Crews will work from dawn to dusk. We ask residents for their patience as it may take time to reach each neighborhood.

Waste Management has confirmed that regular trash pick up is occurring. Residents should put trash out on their regular day.

The City of Margate has NOT issued a boil water notice. However, the city is urging residents to conserve water, which includes reducing the frequency of toilet flushes.

Along with Broward County, the city has issued a curfew that is in effect through the hours of 7:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m. It will remain in effect until further notice.
