RE: HVAC System Contractor Limitation Changes

Recommendation

Due to the recent Florida Statute 489.105 Modification derived from the recently signed Senate Bill 612, it is recommended that an Electrical Inspection be performed when an HVAC System Contractor provides services within the new statute's scope (all line side work). An electrical permit is not required, but an electrical plan review and inspection by an Electrical Inspector must be performed.

Reasons

An electrical inspector is trained to inspect the proper installation of electrical equipment and wiring.

Additional Information

Senate Bill 612 modified the scope of the HVAC system contractor that allows certain contractors to work on the "line side" of the disconnect; this reads as follows:

"Section 1 amends the definition of "Class A air-conditioning contractor," "Class B air conditioning contractor," and "mechanical contractor" to allow them to replace, disconnect, or reconnect power wiring on the line or load side of the dedicated existing electrical disconnect switch on single-phase electrical systems, and to repair or replace power wiring, disconnects, breakers, or fuses for dedicated HVAC circuits."

This Statute went into effect on July 1, 2024.
