Summary of Incident

The Margate Police Department, in conjunction with funding from the Florida Department of Transportation and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, will begin a Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety Campaign during the month of September 2018 and continue through May 2019.

The department has mapped out locations over the past several years where pedestrian and bicycle collisions have occurred, along with the violations that led to those crashes. The campaign will consist of additional officers patrolling areas where bicycle and pedestrian traffic crashes occur. Extra traffic enforcement, along with bicycle and pedestrian violations will be enforced at various locations along West Atlantic Boulevard, North State Road 7, South State Road 7, and Rock Island Road.

The campaign will begin with an education awareness phase with FDOT flyers and safety tips distributed during the campaign. The educational awareness phase will be followed by an enforcement/citation phase.

The goal of the campaign is an effort to lower deaths and injuries to bicyclists and pedestrians in the City of Margate. The Margate Police Department has investigated several fatal collisions involving pedestrians and bicyclists during recent years.
