Summary of Incident:


The Margate Police Department is seeking assistance from the public in the search for a missing endangered person.

Jerry MAZIAS was reported missing by his girlfriend on 03/05/18. He was last seen at 5350 W. Sample Road at approximately 1:25PM. He abandoned the vehicle he was operating in the area of the aforementioned address and left the area in an unknown manner/direction of travel. He was last observed wearing a red shirt and black basketball shorts.

He is approximately 5'09" with a medium build.

MAZIAS has recently been acting irrationally and is possibly hallucinating. Although he is not believed to be armed, it is possible that he has, or will, harm himself.
