GRAND OPENING BANNER REQUIREMENTS

Only one Grand Opening Banner shall be permitted per business.

Shall be installed up to the roof line or top of parapet of the building where the business store front is located.

Maximum area allowed is sixteen (16) square feet for banners on building frontage up to 30 feet. An additional one square foot may be added to a banner for each additional two feet of building frontage over thirty (30) feet.

Banner approval must be obtained from the Department of Development Services within 365 days of the issuance of the first local business tax receipt for a business at a new location, the transfer of an existing business, or the registration of a fictitious name with the Division of Corporation of the Florida Department of State.

Banner and grand opening ground sign may be displayed for a maximum of sixty (60) consecutive days of Bond Agreement.

Any Grand Opening Banners found to be displayed after the approved 60 days, shall result in forfeiture of \$75.00 bond.

No advertising of specific products or pricing shall be included on any grand opening sign.

A color rendering which illustrates the proposed banner, including dimensions, must be submitted to zoning staff with the banner removal agreement in order receive approval.

A site plan showing the location of feather banners and inflatables with applicable setbacks per Section 39.7(g).

Re-opening Banners shall only be permitted for a business closed for a minimum of 10 days for reorganization or a declared emergency immediately prior to said Re-Opening.
