## City of Margate, Florida Two house fire FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE 7/7/2025

Margate, Fla. — Margate firefighters rescued a dog from a burning home Monday afternoon after battling a blaze at two houses.

Margate fire officials said it appears one home ignited the second house at the 6000 block of Northwest Sixth Street. Fire shot through the roof of both homes, and the roof of one of the houses partially collapsed.

At least one person was home at the time of the fires. There were no injuries.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

The fire began at about 12:57 p.m. and took firefighters about 30-40 minutes to extinguish.

Fire Chief Roberto Lorenzo said the dog was hiding by the sliding glass door, hidden from view. Firefighters heard barking and were able to save the dog from the flames.
